MR. CARDOZO: We are now ready to formally 1 2 begin. Welcome everyone. Thank you, all. Let me note that those 3 watching, the public watching from the outside, we 4 5 want to welcome you and as I understand it they will be seeing just the seven or eight of us on the screen. 6 This is a public meeting. 7 Why don't we start by I guess calling the 8 roll to be sure we are official? So I am Michael 9 Cardozo, the Chair of the Commission. 10 Judge Eng, are you there? 11 JUDGE ENG: I am. Randall Eng, 12 Commissioner. 13 MR. CARDOZO: Ms. Hormozi. 14 15 MS. HORMOZI: Yes, here. Present. MR. CARDOZO: Dr. Lachman. 16 DR. LACHMAN: Here I am. 17 MR. CARDOZO: Mr. Madonia. 18 19 MR. MADONIA: Here. 20 MR. CARDOZO: Mr. Malatras. MR. MALATRAS: Here. 21 MR. CARDOZO: And Mr. Megna. 22 MR. MEGNA: Here. 2.3 MR. CARDOZO: Okay. Welcome all of you. 24 25 Thank you for joining us. I remind you that we have a court reporter, Meredith, who will be transcribing this. Thank you.

So I guess I should just open it up for discussions and comments. I have gotten comments from Mr. Malatras. Anyone else have a view as to what we should be saying?

JUDGE ENG: I would like to confirm the factual accuracy. I'm not sure that I had a chance to see Mr. Malatras's additional comments today, but when I read it last night one thing stood out particularly and that is that I don't think there are 50 Judges that are up for consideration for recertification. I think it was 49. That's what I saw in the reports on this subject.

I'd like to be able to confirm the number of Judges that were considered. And 46, of course, will be fine.

MR. MALATRAS: Judge Eng, I just made it on the second copy, I just streamlined that entire section and just left it at the first sentence just to make it easier, trying to get at the gist more than anything. So I removed that sentence that you referred to.

JUDGE ENG: Thank you, yes. I didn't have a chance to look it over. All right.

MR. MALATRAS: Yes, the second copy would be the version to work off. I sent it later. I was late on my homework so I hope everyone doesn't --

MR. CARDOZO: We won't give you a default on that.

I did, since Judge Marks had made the announcement, just quibbling I guess, he did say, and I defer to Judge Eng as to the numbers, but he did say that among the things that the judiciary would be doing would be reducing the number significantly of certificated judges, and that process is going on right now. So I just wonder, it's not a big deal, but I wonder if we shouldn't be a little bit stronger than what is said on the top of page 12.

DR. LACHMAN: Why is that process starting and going on now before our report?

MR. CARDOZO: It has to be completed by

December 31. I can't speak beyond that because there
have been a number of criticisms that have been
leveled against doing this right now, but that's what

OCA said. Can't change that fact.

But why don't -- why don't Jim and I just try to play a little bit with that sentence if that's fair because I just saw it the way you changed it. I don't feel terribly strongly about it.

DR. LACHMAN: Okay.

MR. CARDOZO: We want to be sure that

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Public Meeting everyone is comfortable with the ultimate document. So I will take Jim's changes that have been done this morning and if I have suggested changes I will run them by Jim first I think to make it simpler and then hopefully we will have an agreement and then I'll circulate the proposed final to everyone. MR. MALATRAS: Sounds good. MS. HORMOZI: Wonderful. Thank you. DR. LACHMAN: Great. MR. CARDOZO: Thank you. Before we leave let me single out, first of

all, I want to thank our court reporter. I want to thank the OCA technology staff Marty and Nick who trained us on this and also to thank in particular Nat Miller, my associate, who really deserves all the credit. If there are any typos it's his fault as well, but he's really done all the work. So, Nat, thank you.
